

EVER WONDERED WHAT IT WOULD BE LIKE TO WORK IN A VINEYARD? COME HELP US HARVEST OUR CROP!



Note: This is Texas agriculture – wear sensible, STURDY shoes for working outdoors – NO OPEN-TOED SANDALS. Bring sunscreen and a good hat with a wide brim. We have a very few pairs of clippers, so please bring your own, if you have them. Bypass clippers are the best for snipping off grape bunches,

but any kind will work. Watch the person working across from you or next to you - two people reaching for the same bunch of grapes at the same time can result in cut fingers.

We welcome your children, but because we will be very busy, you are responsible for their safety and their actions.

We will provide plenty of cold water for you in the vineyard. Keep yourself hydrated, and should you feel the sun start to get to you, please do sit down in the shade and have something to drink. If you start to feel ill, go to the house and sit in the air conditioning for awhile.

As in the rest of Texas, we have our share of things that scratch and bite. Don't stand or sit in fire ant nests (!) and watch for wasps.

Can't make this harvest? Don't worry – there will be another harvest of red grapes this season. Watch for the announcement.
